

NEW CLINICAL STUDY ON CLUSTER HEADACHE

DOCTORS ARE CARRYING OUT AN INVESTIGATIONAL DRUG STUDY FOR CLUSTER HEADACHE PREVENTION

At the moment, a local clinical research study is being tested in two clinical research locations to see if it may help people who suffer from episodic or chronic cluster headaches. (Investigational means that the medication isn't registered for any routine clinical use.)

The studies are running at:

- Gent: UZ Gent, Neurologie
- Liège: CHR Citadelle, Unité de Recherche sur les Céphalées

The studies have been approved by the Ethics Committees of UZ Gent and CHR Citadelle Liège; however, this fact should not to be seen as a motivating factor for participation.

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IF YOU:

- Are 18 to 65 years of age
- Have been diagnosed with cluster headache
